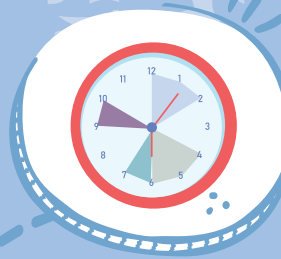




Resistance to change
